Have you been a victim of a recent Scam?

In recent months Wealden residents have become the victims of potential 'Scams' and we want to ensure that nobody is the victim of such frauds.

<u>Recent 'Scams' that have been notified to Citizens</u> <u>Advice include:</u>

- 1. A site posing as HMRC are sending emails to say that you maybe entitled to a tax refund.
- 2. Cold calling from HMRC stating that you will be prosecuted for non-payment of tax, press one for more information.
- 3. Fake emails and telephone calls purporting to be from BT stating that there is a problem with the account and if no further action taken then account will be closed.
- 4. Unsolicited Mobile phone call received from someone stating they were from Citizens Advice. When challenged they immediately hung up.
- 5. Unsolicited emails and text messages being sent out from DVLA attempting to trick drivers to provide and update their personal details via an online link.
