# **We are Citizens Advice Wealden**

Wealden Citizens Advice is an independent charity predominantly resourced by volunteers that provides free, impartial, confidential and independent advice to Wealden residents for the problems they face.

Our team of more than 70 volunteers and 16 paid staff across our 3 offices in Crowborough, Hailsham and Uckfield assisted more than 3,300 clients in 2023/24 with over 17,600 issues. This means each client needed help in more than 5 areas.

We're an important part of the community, with a credible understanding of local needs. We use this to tailor our services and help improve local policies and practices.

# **Our Clients**

47% have a long-term health condition & 8% are classed as disabled.

Age demographics:

37% are aged 45-64 27% are aged 30 – 44 23% are aged 60 or older 10% are aged 30 or younger

Many of our clients are experiencing economic and social disadvantage including living with disabilities, poor mental health, poverty, problem debt, relationship issues, domestic abuse, homelessness and the threat of eviction.

# Our advice is effective

Problems don't happen in isolation and can have severe consequences. Solving them stops these situations escalating.



8 in 10 people said their problem was solved following advice, and 3 in 4 of them said they could not have resolved



**9 out of 10 people** said we helped them find a way forward

Our freephone telephone line 0808 2787811 is open 5 days a week. We identify the key issue that client's need help with during the call and provide them with relevant information to move them forward.

# **Working with local partners**

We work very closely with the Crowborough, Hailsham and Uckfield Food banks. We have a weekly presence at Hailsham foodbank where we receive referrals and advise clients.



We regularly provide our advice service at the Wealden District Council Welfare and Benefits rural outreach days throughout Wealden.



# Our value to society

For every £1 invested in our service in 2023/24 we generated:

#### £1.6m

in savings to government and public services

For every £1 spent on the Citizens Advice service, government and public services save £5.55

#### £11.2m

in wider economic and social benefits

For every £1 spent on the Citizens Advice service, the wider economic and social value is £36.36

**£5m** in financial value to the people we help

For every £1 spent on the Citizens Advice service, people we help are better off by £17.14

# How we calculate our financial value

It's impossible to put a financial value on everything we do – but where we can, we have.

We've used a Treasury-approved model to do this.

From our robust management information, we've also separately considered the financial benefits to the people we help.

- Keeping people in employment or helping them back to work
- Preventing housing evictions and statutory homelessness
- Reducing demand for mental health and GP services
- Improving mental wellbeing and positive functioning
- Improved family relationships
